
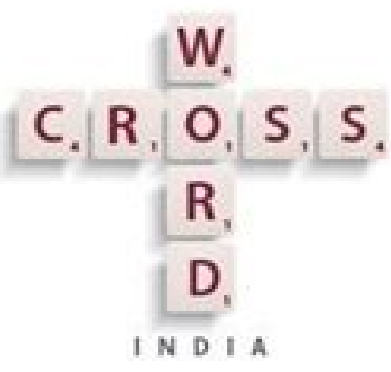


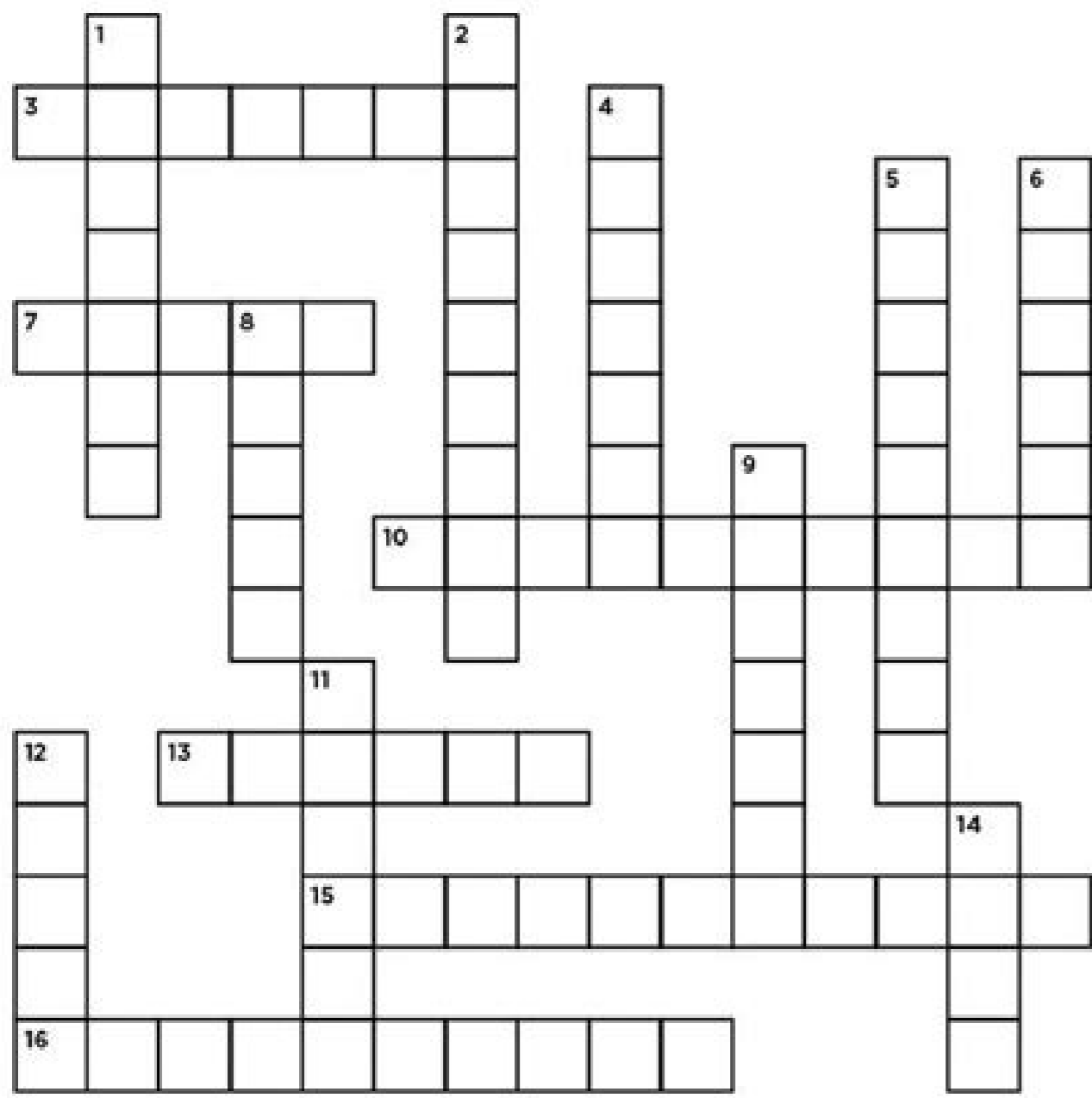

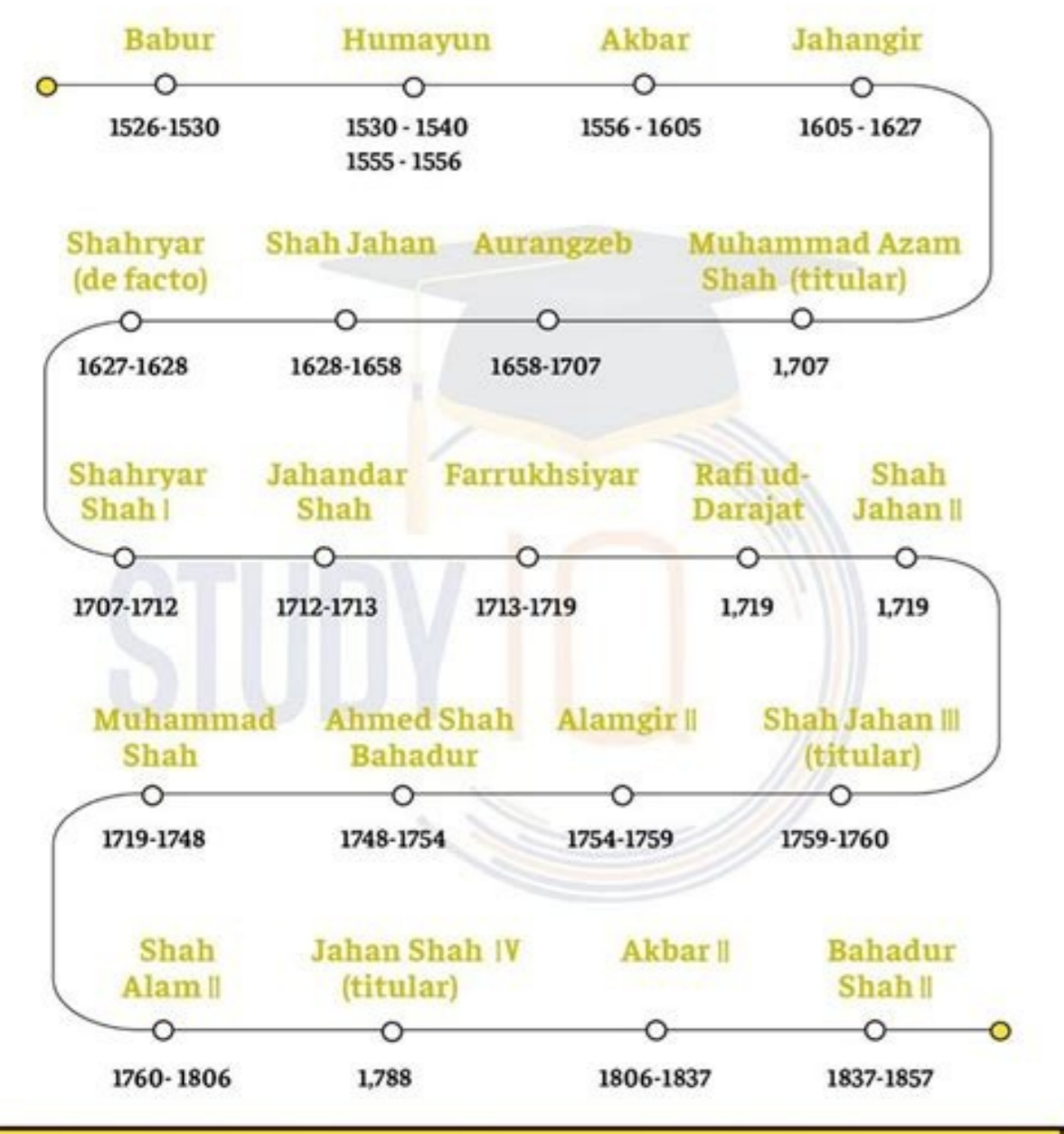

SUMMARY

The Mughal Prince explores how a Muslim, ethnically Turkish, and Persian-speaking dynasty came to establish itself in the Indian subcontinent, becoming the most powerful and most enduring empire in history. Rather than being a foreign invader, the Mughals were a powerful and imaginative administrative institution, the result of a unique and often overlooked role of the Mughal prince in regional state formation, theorizing between 1500 and 1700.

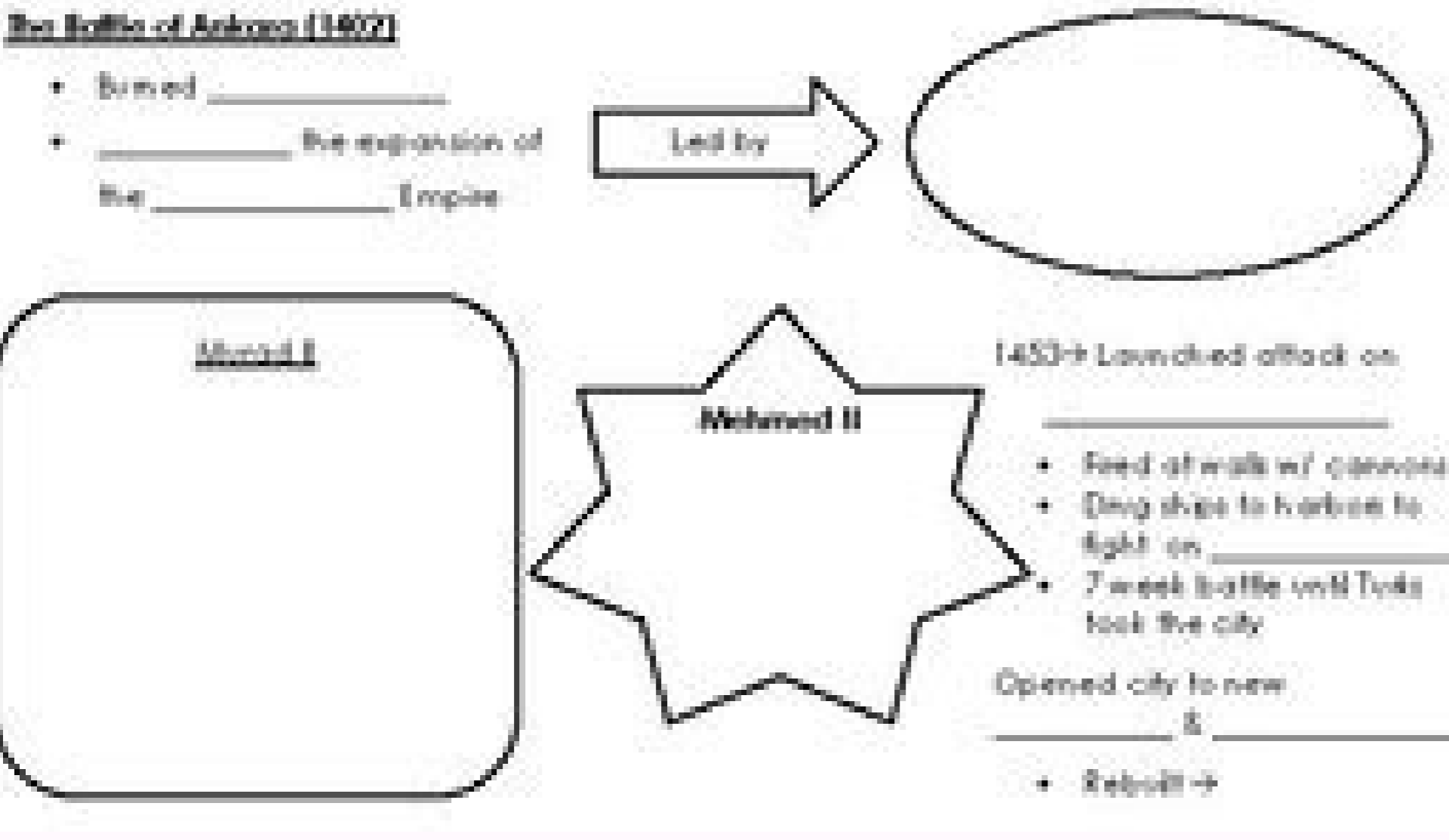
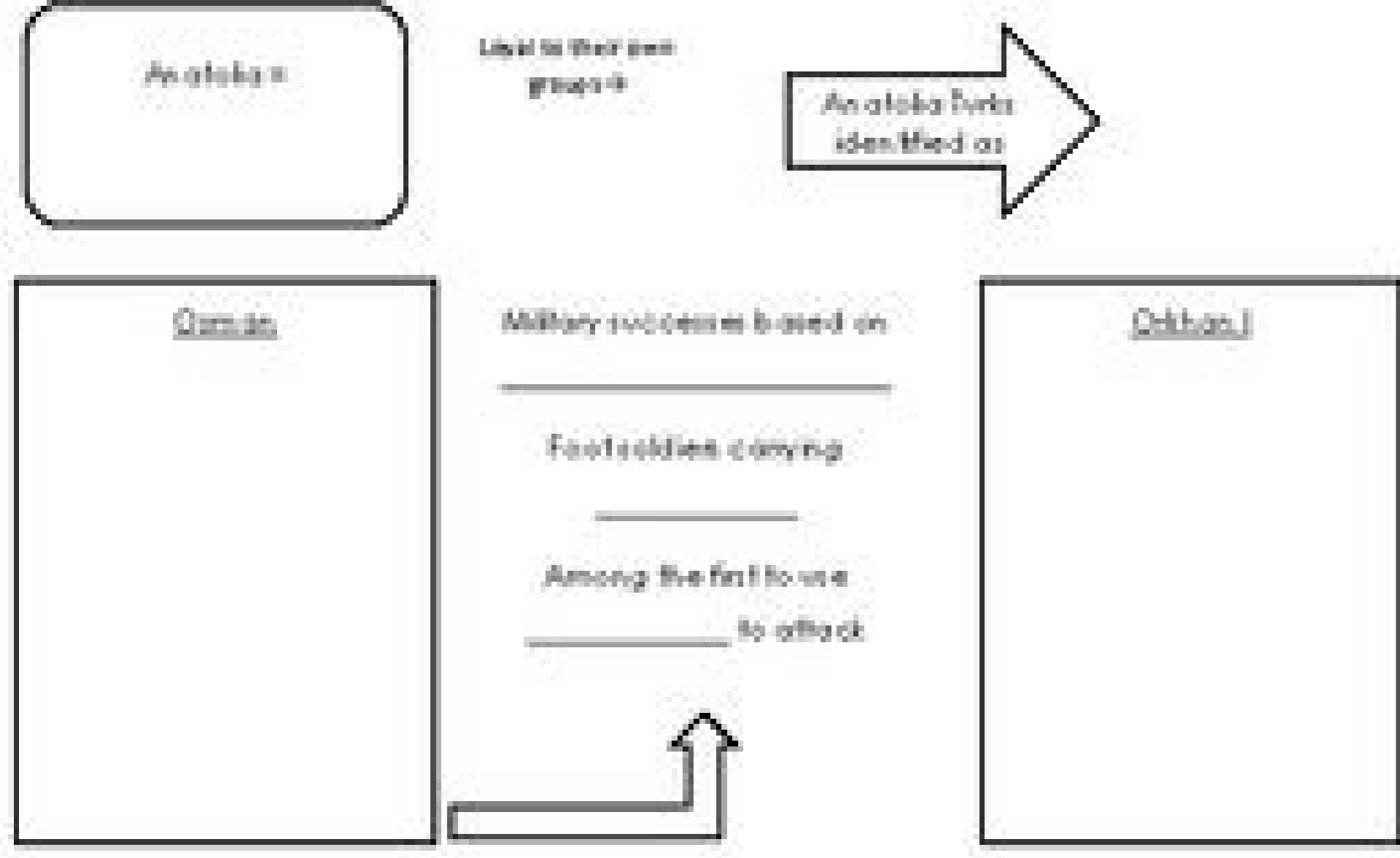
